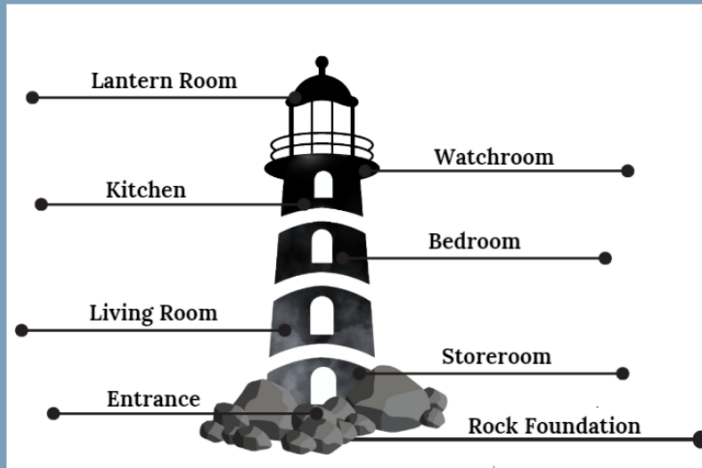


THE PARTS OF THE LIGHTHOUSE

SESSION SUMMARIES

- **Rock Foundation**

How we view God affects how we see ourselves and others. Since we are made in His image, we reflect Him.

- **Entrance & Stairs**

Childhood experiences build an attachment blueprint in our brain. We need to get on the same step with these patterns.

- **Storeroom**

Just as the lighthouse needed stores of water, oil and coal, we need deposits of connection to weather storms.

- **Living Room**

Furniture is arranged to create a relaxing space; boundaries are necessary to establish peace and security in marriage.

- **Bedroom**

A Biblical narrative of sexuality can help us see how everyone is on a journey of sexual integrity to model the love of God.

- **Kitchen**

"If you can't stand the heat, get out of the kitchen." When life gets hot, we can help to regulate and comfort each other.

- **Watch Room**

In the lighthouse, things broke down and needed repair. Repair techniques are needed after conflict and frustrations to rebuild.

- **Lantern Room**

God is the constant source of light, even as we experience change. Marriages travel through stages and we can trim our wick and shine brightly in each season of life.
